On 21 July 2026, students of Classes 5 to 7 attended the session "Introduction to Life Skills – Grow : Learn : Connect", conducted by Dr. Samir Shah, Dr. Bhupendra, Dr. Snehal, and Dr. Hitesh Vasava.

The session focused on the importance of life skills in personal and social development.
